Supplementary materials

Olink biomarkers

The following Olink biomarker panels were used: Cardiovascular II (CVII), CVD III, Immune response and Oncology II. Across the panels there were several duplicates; B-natriuretic peptide (BNP) and N-terminal pro-B-type natriuretic peptide (NT-proBNP) in CVDII and CVDIII panels; amphiregulin (AREG) in the Immune response and Oncology II panel; stem cell factor (SCF) in oncology II and CVDIII; and interleukin 6 in CVDII, Immune response and Oncology II panels.

Detailed information about the 363 biomarkers used in this analysis can be found online(1–4). Figure S1 and S2 show that the biomarker set used encompassed biomarkers from a wide range of biological processes and diseases.

Cluster analysis

The aim of this study was to identify mutually exclusive HFpEF clusters based on biomarker profiles. Supplementary figure 4 summarises the statistical approach used. Due to the large set of biomarkers, we sought to reduce the dimension of the data using principle component analysis (PCA). PCA was performed on all 363 biomarkers using the prcomp package in R. Fifty-nine principle components (PCs) with a minimum eigenvalue of 1 were used as input for the cluster analysis. The optimal number of clusters was determined using the NbClust package in R. NbClust uses 30 indices to determine the optimal cluster number by picking the number of clusters that is calculated in the majority of these indices(5). NbClust determined 6 to be the optimal number of clusters (Supplementary figure 4). A hierarchical cluster analysis using complete linkage was performed using the 59 PCs as input.

Cluster 5 and 6 were small clusters and therefore not included in the downstream analyses. Table *S1* shows an overview of these patients characteristics.

Figure S1. Overview of GO biological processes of Olink biomarker proteins

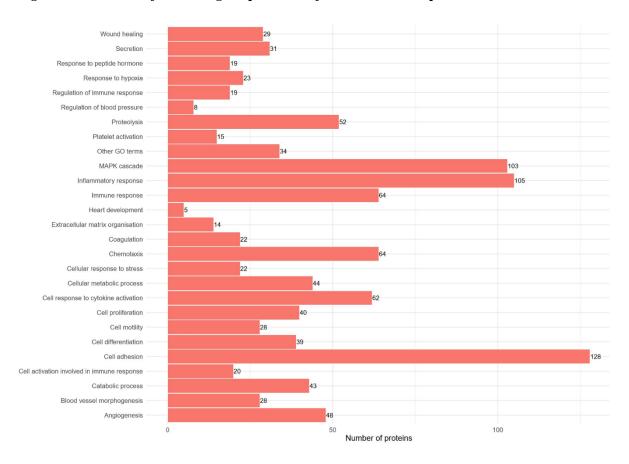


Figure S2. Pie chart depicting the proportion of Olink biomarkers involved in each disease area.

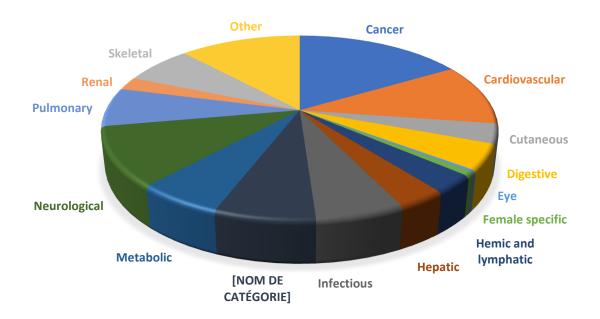


Figure S3: Variance explained for the top 10 principle components.

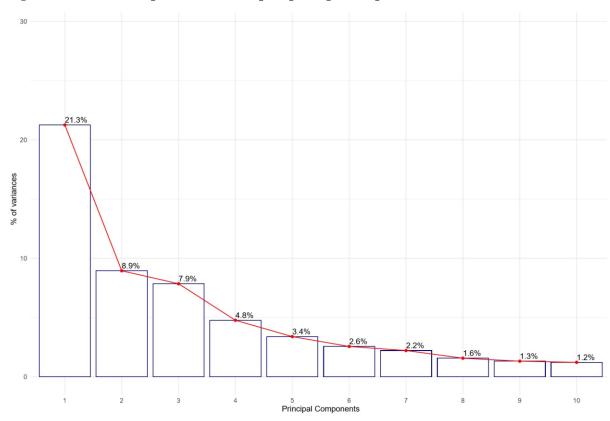


Figure S4. NbClust: optimal number of clusters according to indices.

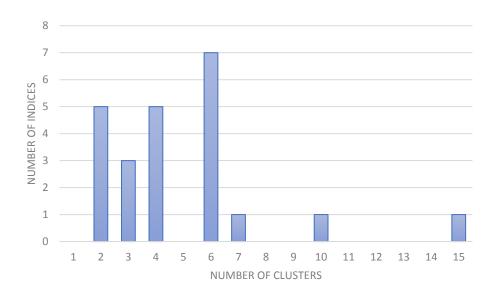


Figure S5. Flow chart of cluster analysis

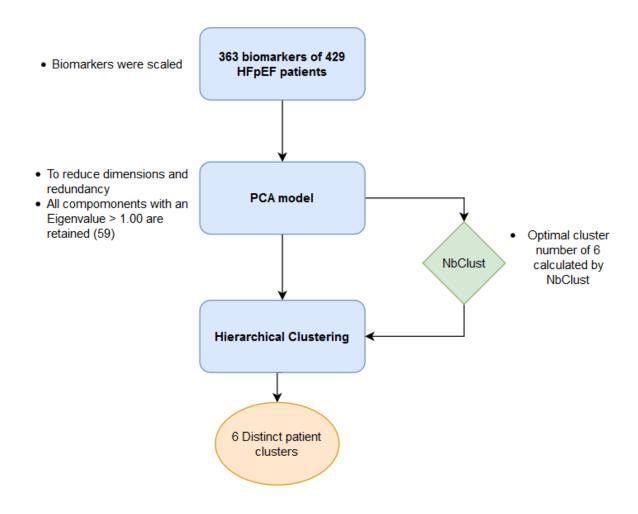
