Fast Fourier Transform — « FFT » Solvers	<ul> <li>No meshing         Direct processing of real microstructures ("Tomo' /SEM" images) or models     </li> </ul>	0 0
	Best suited for <b>complex microstructures!</b> Much <b>more efficient</b> than standard EF solvers <b>Easy</b> to implement Well adapted for <b>Parallelization</b>
