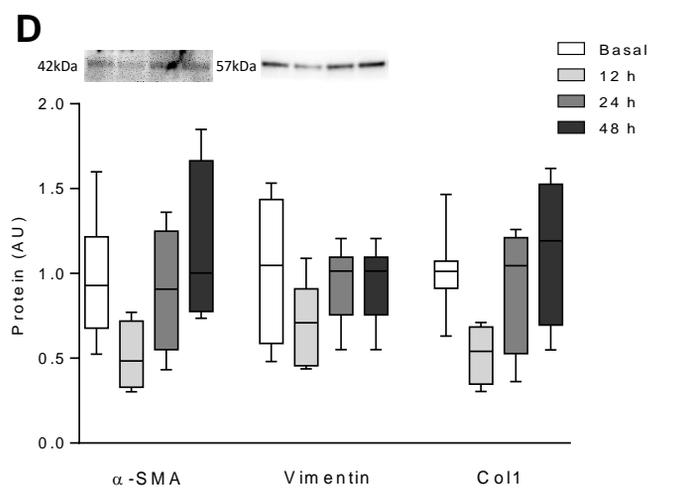
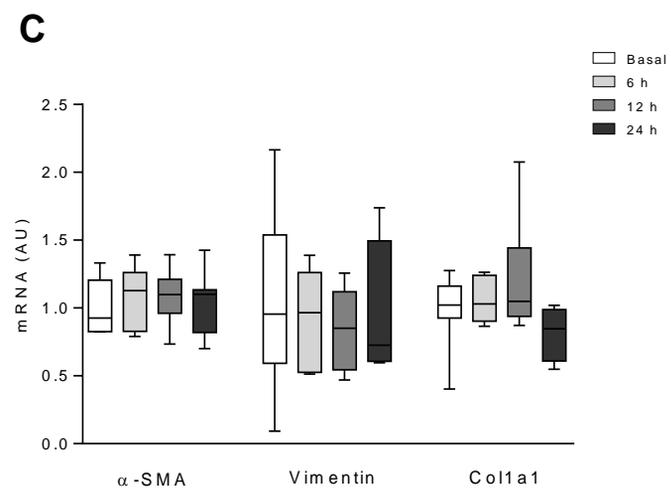
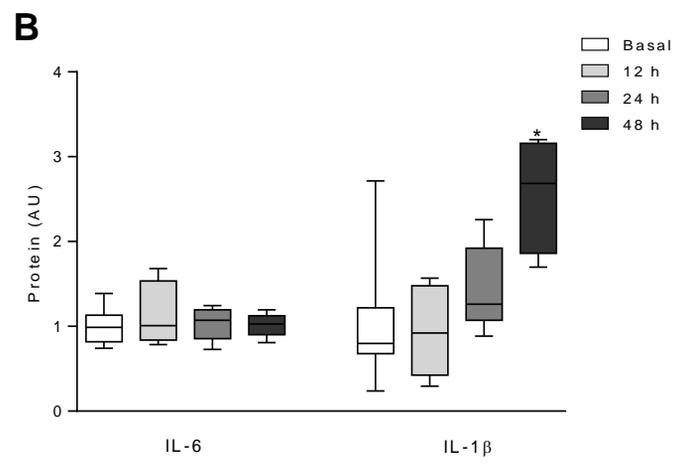
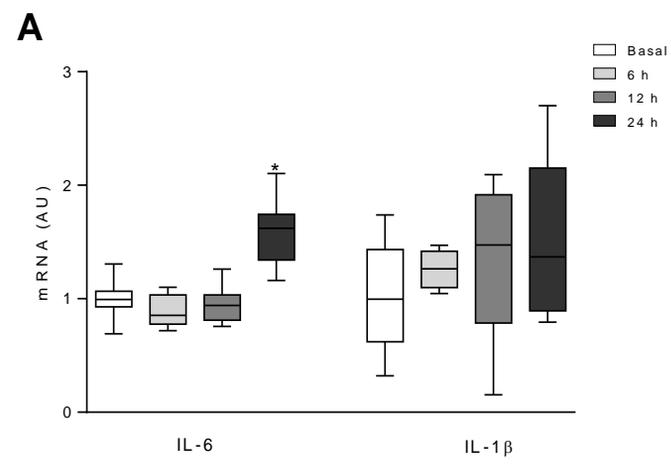

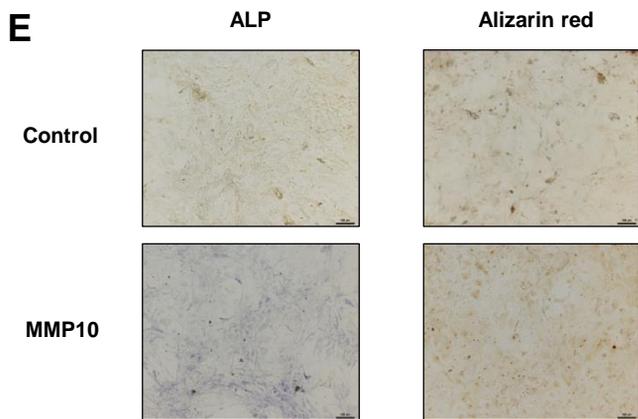
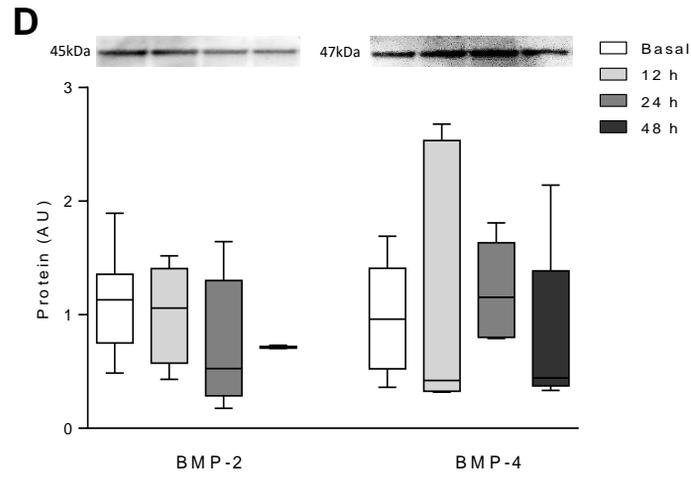
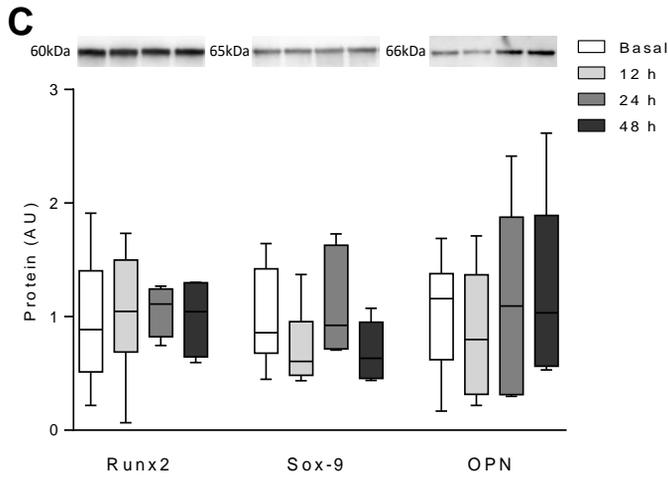
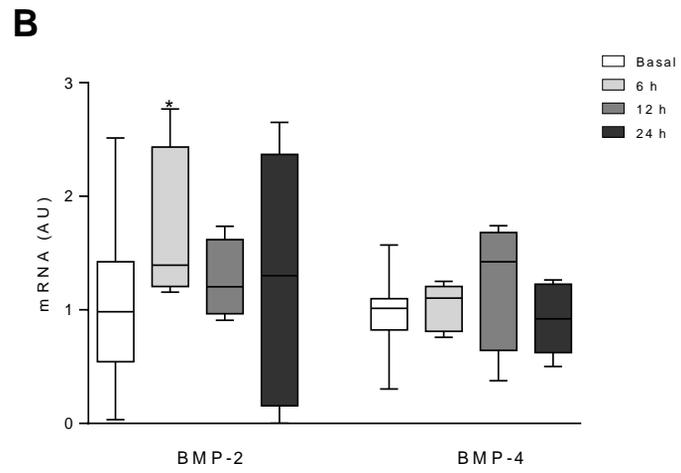
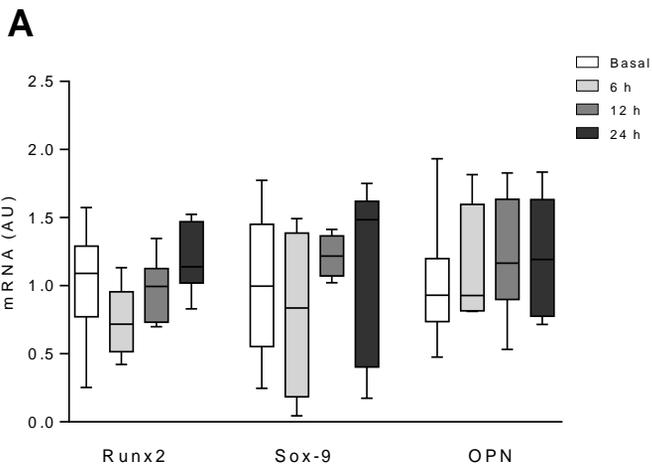
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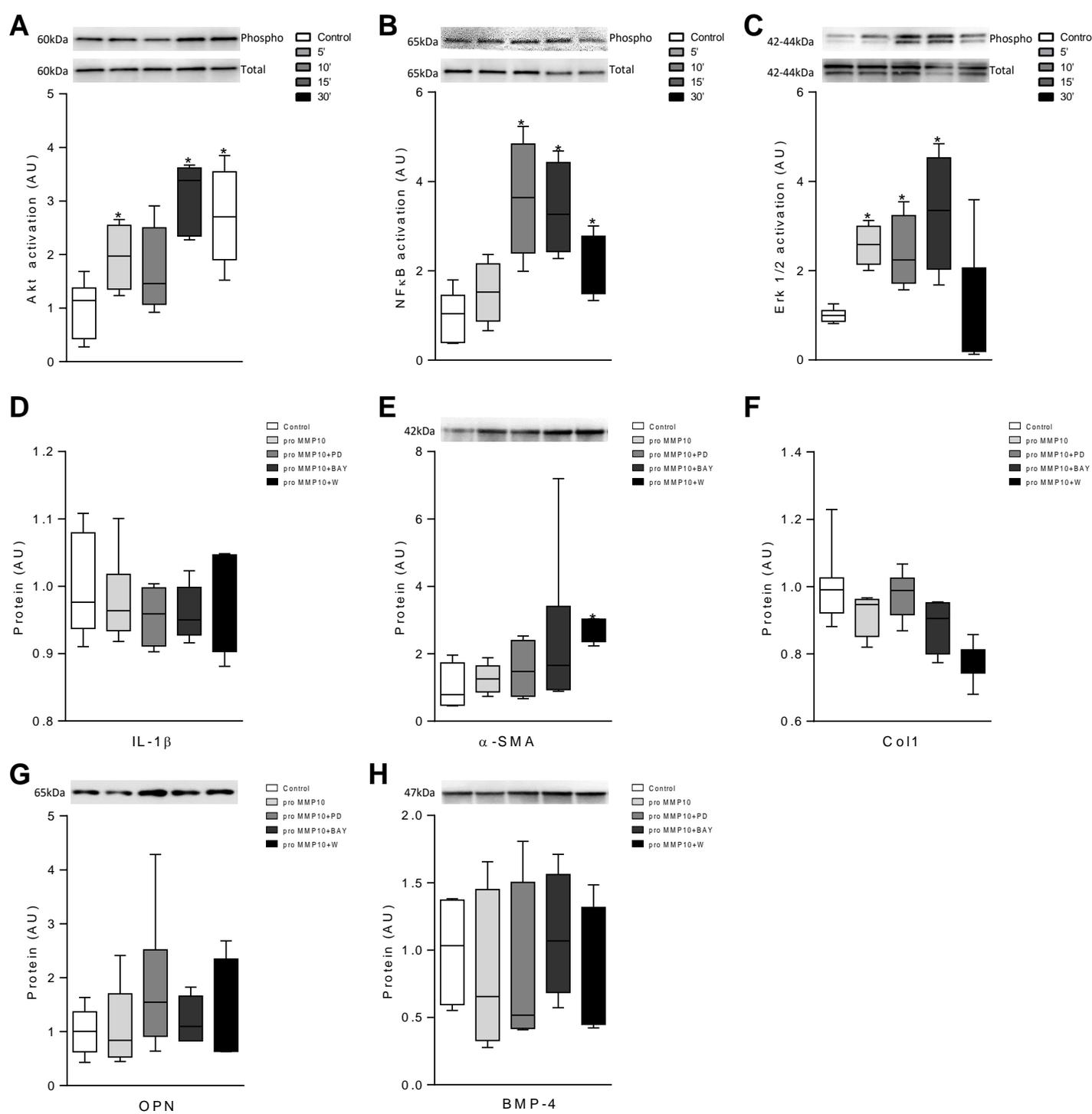

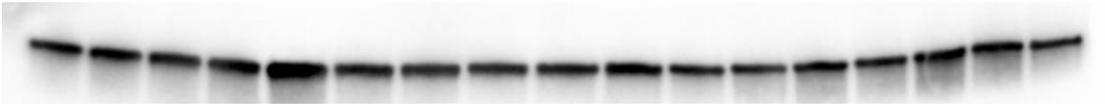




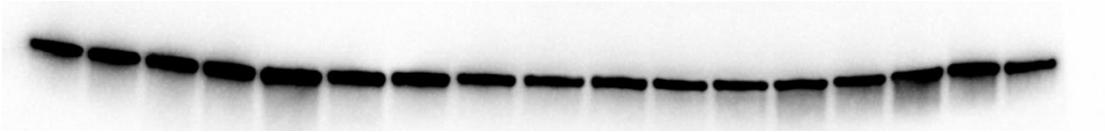

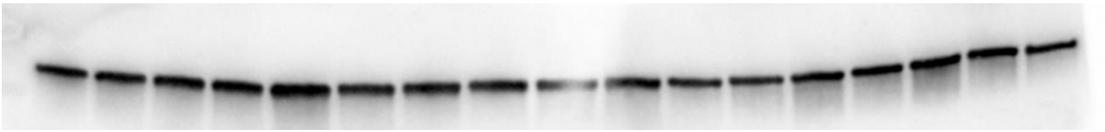

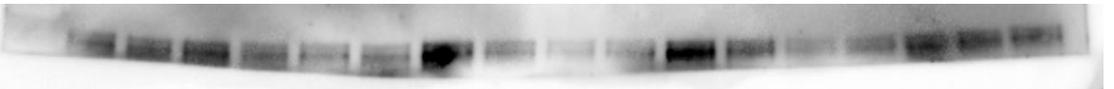

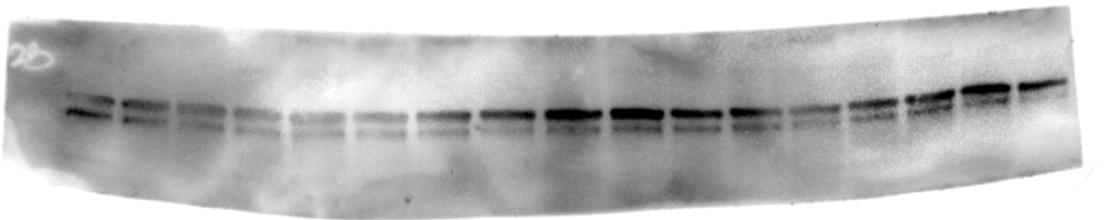

SUPPLEMENTAL FIGURE LEGENDS

Supplemental Figure I. proMMP10 induces inflammatory expression in AVICs. Effects of proMMP10 on the inflammatory markers IL-6 mRNA levels (A) and IL-6 and IL1 β secretion (B). α -SMA, vimentin and Col1a1 mRNA (C) and protein (D) levels in AVICs treated with 10^{-9} M proMMP10. All conditions were performed at least in triplicate. Whisker plots represent median and minimum to maximum range of 6 assays in arbitrary units (AU) normalized to HPRT, β -actin and GADPH for cDNA and to stain free for protein. * $p < 0.05$ vs Control. proMMP10: Pro metalloproteinase 10; IL-6: interleukin 6; IL1 β : interleukin 1 beta; α -SMA: alpha smooth muscle actin; Col1a1: collagen Type I Alpha 1 Chain.

Supplemental Figure II. proMMP10 effects on AVICs osteogenesis. Runx2, Sox-9 and osteopontin mRNA expressions in AVICs treated with 10^{-9} M proMMP10 (A). BMP-2 and BMP-4 mRNA expressions in AVICs treated with proMMP10 (B). Protein expressions of Sox-9, osteopontin (C), BMP-2 and BMP-4 (D) in AVICs incubated with proMMP10. ALP staining of AVICs cultivated with proMMP10 at day 14 (E). Alizarin red staining of AVICs cultivated with 10^{-9} M proMMP10 at day 14 (F). All conditions were performed at least in triplicate. Whisker plots represent median and minimum to maximum range of 6 assays in arbitrary units (AU) normalized to HPRT, β -actin and GADPH for cDNA and to stain free for protein. * $p < 0.05$ vs Control. proMMP10: Pro metalloproteinase 10; Runx2: runt-related transcription factor 2; Sox-9: SRY (sex-determining region Y)-box 9; OPN: osteopontin; BMP-2: bone morphogenetic protein-2; BMP-4: bone morphogenetic protein-4.

Supplemental Figure III. Effects of proMMP10 on phosphorylation of intracellular pathways in AVICs and effects of cell signaling chemical inhibitors on the inflammatory, fibrotic and osteogenic effects of proMMP10 in AVICs. Akt (A), NF κ B (B) and ERK1/2 (C) phosphorylation was measured by Western Blot in AVICs treated with 10^{-9} M proMMP10 at 5, 10, 15, 30 and 60 minutes. IL-1 β (D), α -SMA (E), Collagen type I (F), osteopontin (G) and BMP-4 (H) protein expressions were measured by Western Blot or ELISA in AVICs pre-treated with PD98059, BAY117082 or Wortmannin 30 minutes before the addition proMMP10 (10^{-9} M final) and incubated for 24 h. All conditions were performed at least in triplicate. Whisker plots represent median and minimum to maximum range of 6 assays in arbitrary units (AU) normalized to stain free for protein and total Akt, total NF κ B, and total ERK1/2. * $p < 0.05$ vs Control. ProMMP10: pro-metalloproteinase 10; Akt: protein kinase B; NF κ B: nuclear factor kappa B; Erk1/2: extracellular signal-regulated kinase 1 and 2. IL-1 β : interleukin 1 beta; α -SMA: alpha smooth muscle actin; Col1: collagen Type I; OPN: osteopontin; BMP-4: bone morphogenetic protein-4.
